	<p>Over 50 countries, representing 40% of the world’s population, are at risk of a drinking water shortage by 2025. Successfully using and conserving water is therefore a key challenge for all of us. Half the world’s fresh water reserves are today polluted, despite strict regulations and massive investments. <b>Water resources</b> in some areas are overexploited and pollution from nitrates, which are used heavily in agriculture, remain a concern.
