
Lt. Gen. J. S. Ahluwalia, PVSM (Retd.)

He appointed to this position in May 2018. A distinguished leader, he has held many senior positions with the Central Government including Additional Secretary- Urban Affairs and Joint Secretary- Smart Cities, with the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs; Joint Secretary- Housing, Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation Ministry (HUPA), amongst others. As Director, Ministry of Home, with the Govt. of India, he was instrumental in formation of the Uttarakhand States and the reorganisation of Uttar Pradesh State. Previously, he has also been the Managing Director of Indian Tourism Development Corporation (ITDC).

A policy maker and transformational leader, he leads the 'National Urban Policy Framework' (2020) as Chairman of the Policy Preparation; he has also led the 'Report of the Group of Secretaries on Health, Sanitation and Urban Development' (2017); Value Capture Finance Policy Framework (2017); 'India: Smart City Mission' policy making and designing process (2015); the 'India: AMRUT Mission' (2015); as the Mission Director, with Ministry of Home Development at the Centre; amongst many others. Mr. U. K. Sinha, IAS (Retd.) served as the Chairman of Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) for a period over six years between 2011 and 2017. During his stewardship SEBI is credited with having brought in significant regulatory amendments in areas such as Takeover Code, Foreign Portfolio Investors, Alternate Investment Funds, REITIs, InVITs., Corporate Governance etc. Prior to this; Mr. Sinha was the Chairman and Managing Director at UTI Asset Management Company Pvt Ltd from 2005 until February 2011. Preceding this, he was the Joint Secretary in Department of Economic Affairs at Ministry of Finance and looked after Banking Division and Capital Markets Division – including external commercial borrowings, pension reforms and foreign exchange management functions.

For his contribution as Chairman SEBI, Mr Sinha was conferred with many awards viz. CNBC-TV18 India Business Leader Awards (IBLA) – Outstanding Contribution to Indian Business Award 2014 and Economic Times - Business Reformer of the Year Award 2014 to name a few. Mr. Sinha was selected for the Indian Administrative Service in 1976. He holds a M.Sc. and LLB degree.

Mr. Bhatt led SBI during challenging times and under his leadership, SBI rose on the global list rankings of Fortune 500.

He was also Chairman of Indian Banks' Association, the apex body of Indian banks and has served as India's economic diplomacy as government's nominee on the India-US CEO Forum, Indo-French CEO Forum and Indo-Russia CEO Forum, forging links with a cross section of the world's business leaders. He is also a Governor on the Board of Centre for Creative Leadership, USA. Mr. Bhatt was nominated Banker of the Year by Business Standard and Indian of the Year for Business in 2007 by CNN-IBN. He a graduate in Science and a post graduate in English Literature.


Dr. Niraj Gupta



He was also a member of another Study Group constituted by the PMO in 2006 for designing and planning in-service training for IAS officers at junior, middle and senior level. The recommendations of the Study Group have been accepted and already implemented.
