Mr. Prasad talked about the Ministry of MSME, Government of India's initiatives for digitalization, MSME Department designed MY MSME website to be user-friendly as all the MSME schemes are digitalized, it will be convenient for the MSME to know the

schemes and accessible to it. He also explained various MSME schemes, Certifications and support system extended to the MSMEs. He commented saying, Indian industries are not coming forward to avail the schemes created by Central and State Government to upgrade and adopt new technologies for the industries. He also added that, food processing has great potential in Indian industry and also for the export business, if MSMEs can focus on delivering high quality products; there is lot of export opportunities available for them. He concluded saying, MSME Department is digitalized everything, it's just visit the website and avail the right scheme to upgrade your business.

Ms. Jaggi said that one of the key initiatives of the Telangana State Government's is the **Telangana State GlobalLinker**, which is essentially a social networking platform for companies (much like Facebook, LinkedIn, etc.). It is a platform for business networking and a means to explore different aspects of doing business. She also discussed other 'Made in Telangana' projects.

Mr. Reddy shared information on the State Government's initiatives and success stories, and also mentioned that all the schemes are digitalized and the department is working in a time bound manner. He also talked about various schemes, incentives and support extended to the industry.

ENHANCING COMPETITIVENESS OF MSMEs THROUGH DIGITAL TRANSFORMATION & DIGITALIZATION IS KEY TO BUILD MSME

The 'Chief Guest Address' was delivered by:

Dr. E. Vishnu Vardhan Reddy, IFS

Special Secretary, Investment Promotion & NRI Affairs; Joint Managing Director, Telangana State Trade Promotion Corporation Limited (TSTPC)

Dr. Reddy emphasised the necessity for innovation in the MSME Sector. The government of Telangana has made 'innovation' and 'entrepreneurship' its top goals. Being a recently constituted State, it has flourished and developed an ecosystem for innovation and entrepreneurship during the past nine years, giving rise to T-HUB, T-Works, WE HUB, TSIC, and other ventures. He spoke about how ChatGPT operates and how businesses have embraced it. He placed emphasis on MSMEs' need to upgrade their digital skills. The dynamics of the 'Raising and Accelerating MSME Performance (RAMP)' initiative, which is backed by the World Bank, were also discussed by him. This scheme shall address the challenges of achieving the results identified by the 'MSME Competitiveness: A Post COVID Resilience and Recovery Programme' (MCRRP) and support to the delivery of higher-quality integrated services to MSMEs. He also added that Telangana State is currently in the first stage of having a dedicated MSME Green Industrial Park. He concluded by saying, 'Today's Start-Ups can be tomorrow's MSMEs.'

The 'Closing Remarks' were proposed by Mr. Sandeep Chatterjee, Supply Chain and Sustainable Leader at IBM Consulting and also Member, IOD Hyderabad Region. He mentioned that MSME in India contributes as much as 30% of National GDP and as much as 40% of gross exports, with an ambitious target of 50% by 2025. While digitalization is slow, 64% of MSMEs have an online presence. On a closing note, he emphasised Sustainability and the need to adopt a responsible approach to the way business leads.

They discussed leveraging digital technologies, optimising business processes, adopting emerging technologies, and staying competitive in the digital era. Digitalization has had a revolutionary impact on MSMEs, playing a crucial role in their growth. It has become a driving force for

their success and will continue to shape their future. Collaborative efforts between banks, government policies, and industry bodies are essential to realising the full potential of these small businesses. With the right support and resources, MSMEs will thrive, making significant contributions to India's economic progress and job creation.
